1	family	A group of people who may live together.
2	family tree	A diagram to show all the people in a family and their relationship.
3	lifetime	The time we have been alive (4 or 5 years).
4	Queen of England	The Queen of England is Queen Elizabeth II.
5	Queen's Sapphire Jubilee	On the 6th February 2017 Queen Elizabeth had been the Queen of England for 65years.
6	Duke and Duchess of Sussex	Prince Charles' son Harry married Meghan in 2018, making them the Duke and Duchess of Sussex.
7	Queen's Jubilee	On the 6th February 2022 Queen Elizabeth had been the Queen of England for 70 years.
8	Queen Victoria	Queen Victoria became the Queen of England in 1837, she was the Queen for 64years.
