What we have learnt already

I can tell you the names of people in my **family tree**. I can talk about things that have happened in **my family** during my **lifetime**. I can find out things that happened in **my family** before I was **born**.

I can name and recognise **Queen Victoria**. I know that **Queen Victoria** was the **Queen of England** over **150 years** ago.

I know that **Florence Nightingale** was also known as **The Lady with the Lamp** (so she could check the injured soldiers). I can name and recognise **Florence Nightingale**. I know that **Florence Nightingale** was a **Nurse**.

Words we need to know

1	diablo	A toy that is spun with string and two hand sticks.
2	whip and top	A wooden top that is spun using a leather lace.
3	hoop and stick	Wooden or Iron hoops that were hit with a stick to make them move.
4	Florence Nightingale	A Nurse who looked after sick and injured soldiers in the war.
5	Nurse	A nurse is a person who is trained to give care to people who are sick or injured.
6	The Lady with the Lamp	Florence Nightingale was called this as she often worked at night checking the soldiers with a lamp.

What we will learn next

I know that the **Clock Tower in Newmarket** was built to remember **Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee**. I can identify **Victorian houses in Newmarket**. I can describe the features (**decorative brickwork, chimney, bay and sash windows and an outside toilet**). I can identify **Victorian buildings** in Newmarket (**Clock Tower & School**).

I know how the **seaside has changed over time** (**bathing machines, fully clothed, sea-bathing**).

I know that **Queen Victoria** reigned for nearly 64 years and was the longest serving monarch until **Queen Elizabeth II**. I know that **Queen Elizabeth II** is now the longest serving monarch from **1952- 2022**.
