Summer Term 2024 – Buildings & Beaches



Children should be reading at least three times a week, any book either from school or home and recording it in their reading record. In addition to this they can log on to Numbots to support their Maths learning at home and EdShed to practise weekly spellings. Children can also choose (an optional task) linked to our BIG IDEAS. They only have to complete one of these tasks BUT if they would like to do more than one then that is great. Please share any work on Class Dojo so we can celebrate in class and also any 'at home' adventures they would like to share with their friends in class. We love seeing what they have been doing and achieving.

WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK:

Reading at least 3 x a week (they should read to you but also it is great for you to model and read to them, a great alternative if they are tired)
Weekly Spellings, try and play the games online at least twice a week.

Language: 'What key vocabulary can you learn linked to Buildings & Beaches?'

Using the Knowledge Organiser what key vocabulary can you spot and write some sentences using them, perhaps you can draw pictures to help explain them, it will be History focussed this half term and Geography next half term so you can choose which ones interest you.

People: 'What beaches have your family been to and which is their favourite?'

Talk to your family, what beaches have they been to? Are they in the UK or another country? What did they see or do there? Did they see any animals? Record your interview or write a report about what you found out.

Migration: 'What are beaches like in other countries?'

If you have been to another country that has a beach, what was the same and what was different? Can you draw or write about it, perhaps you can share a photo with the class showing you at that beach. If you haven't been anywhere you could look on the internet with a grown up.

WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK:

Numbots, ideally 20mins 3 x a week when possible.

Britain: 'Where are there sandy beaches in Britain?'

Can you find the best beach in Britain? What makes it the best? Who decides? Can you use the internet with a grown up to find out more or perhaps decide from beaches you have visited here in Suffolk or somewhere in the UK you have visited with your family. Share everything you know with us in class.

Faith: 'What buildings do different faiths worship in?'

At All Saints we link with All Saints Church as we are a Christian School, you could go and visit our church and share something new you found out or if you visit a different place of worship with your family can you record you telling us more about it or share something you have written or drawn about it with the class.

Creativity: 'Can you make a model building or beach?'

How creative are you feeling? You could make a beach landscape from construction at home or get the craft and junk modelling out and make a building of your choice, can you recreate the Clock Tower or our school? Use whatever you want and have fun and be creative.
