WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK: Read at home for at least 10 mins three times a week. Please log that you have read with your child in their reading diaries. Spelling practice – Spelling Shed games and tests.	WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK: NumBots covers key Maths skills and children enjoy playing the games.
<b>Language:</b> We will be writing poems based around fireworks and light. Can you write a poem based on a celebration? Remember, poems do not need to rhyme but they do need interesting vocabulary!	<b>Britain:</b> Look at a map of England. Can you write a list of some of the largest cities?
<b>People:</b> We will be learning about Remembrance Day and why we celebrate it. Can you make a fact file of everything you remember about Remembrance Day and why we celebrate it.	<b>Faith:</b> . Our value this term is TRUTH. Year 2 always talk about how important it is to tell the truth. Talk to an adult about the importance of telling the truth and write these in your homework book.
