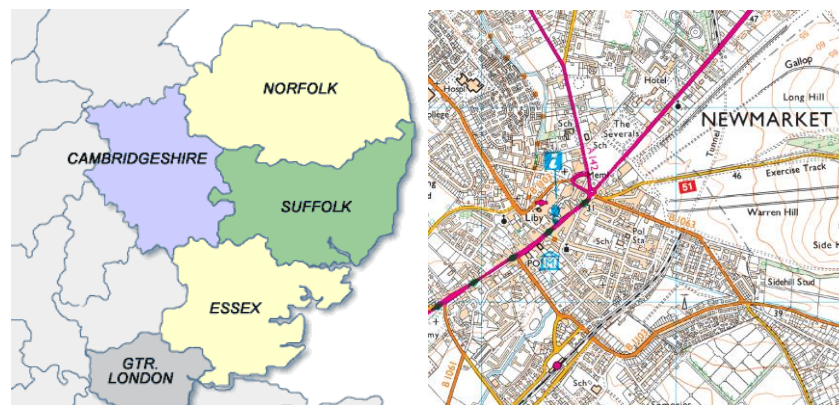

Knowledge Gems – what I will learn

Locate 	I can locate Suffolk, Cambridgeshire and Norfolk on a map of East Anglia and I can locate Newmarket on a map of Suffolk. I can locate Newmarket train station on a map of Newmarket and I can map a route from the school to the train station.
Navigate 	I can use fieldwork skills to record the key human features in Newmarket town centre (shops, restaurants, cafes, facilities, church). - I can identify symbols (footpaths, railways, road, nature reserve, cycle trail etc.) on an Ordnance Survey map.
Explore 	I can describe the similarities and differences between a city (London), a town (Newmarket) and a village (Kennett) e.g. size of the places, facilities available, population. I can describe how railways connect people and places around the country.

Words we need to know

Ordnance Survey Map	A map which shows all the roads, paths, hills etc of an area in detail.
Grid Ref:	Grid references are used to locate a particular square on a map.
City	An inhabited place of greater size, population, or importance than a town or village. City status in the UK can be associated with having a cathedral or a university, a particular form of local government, or having a large population.
Town	A built-up area with a name, defined boundaries, and local government, that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.
Village	Villages are small settlements with a small number of houses for a few hundred people.
Population	The number of people or inhabitants in a country or region.
Facilities	Are buildings, pieces of equipment, or services that are provided for a particular purpose.
