WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK:

At least 10 mins daily reading practice – AIM HIGH for 15 mins a day!
Spelling practice – edshed games and weekly word list. A new set of spellings will be sent home weekly.

Language: Find and write definitions for the following words linked to your geography topic on rainforests: rainforest, climate, tropics, equator, deforestation, habitat and indigenous.

People: Using the link, find out about the indigenous people who live in the rainforest. Write a summary of what you learnt.

Migration: Find out what it would be like to travel to Brazil. What tourist attractions would you see and what activities could you do? What is Brazil famous for? What would you need to pack in your suitcase if you travelled to Brazil?

WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK:

Times tables practice up to x12 and divisions – games, songs, oral reciting, TT Rockstars etc. can be used to support this at home. A weekly worksheet will be sent home to support learning times tables.

Britain: Make a fact page comparing the Amazon rainforest to Newmarket. Include information such as: weather, climate, land use, animals, human (man made – shops, roads, railways) and physical (natural – rainforest) geographical features.

Faith: Christianity is the main religion in South America and you will find beautifully hand painted crosses. Create your own painted version of a cross or symbol of your choice.



Creativity: Research The Dreams of Henri Rousseau. Create your own version of rainforest as your inspiration – use collage/paint/drawing.
