## WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK: <br> At least 10mins daily reading practice - AIM HIGH for 15 mins a day! Spelling practice - look, cover check and write these words in sentences if needed. A new set of spellings will be sent home weekly.

Language: The Second World War was fought between many countries and many languages spoke. Learn some words in German. Can you create a vocabulary sheet of common German words and their English translation?

People: Who was Adolf Hitler? Who was Winston Churchill? What did they have to do with World War II? Research each of these men and draw or print an image about them and write down some facts about each.

Migration: Where did people migrate to during the Second World War? How did people move from country to country? How did soldiers travel which was different to the First World War? Draw or print an image of a soldier of your choice in a vehicle of your choice.

## WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK:

Times tables practice - games, songs, oral reciting, IT Rockstars etc. can be used to support this at home. Year 4 will occasionally be given extra maths work to support their learning.

Britain: When the soldiers were fighting and away from their jobs, what did the women in Britain do? Did they sit around, waiting for their men to come back? No! They helped the war effort by becoming Land Army girls and working in factories making bullets and machinery. Research what they did and how this hugely helped the war effort. Do you know of any women who helped in Britain while the war was going on?

Faith: What do you know about the word 'morality'? Did everyone agree with the War? Some people thought the War was morally wrong. Do you agree? Disagree? Why?

Creativity: Create/copy a Land Army or a Second World War poster about rationing. Can you recreate the same wartime style?
