WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK:

At least 10mins daily reading practice – AIM HIGH for 15mins a day!
Spelling practice – look, cover check and write these words in sentences if needed. A new set of spellings will be sent home weekly.

Language: This term we are learning about poetry. Can you write an acrostic for your name? An acrostic is where you write your name down the side of the page and write one line starting with each letter of your name. Look at the example to the left of my acrostic poem.

People: In World War 2 lots of countries were at war including Britain, Germany, France, Poland, Italy, USA and Japan. Who are the leaders of those countries now and can you find out 2 facts about each one of them. Maybe how old they are, the colour of their hair, how many children they have.

Migration: In World War 2 people migrated to different parts of England. Can you remember who and why they migrated? If you needed to be evacuated what would you pack in your suitcase and why. Imagine you could only take 10 things with you.

WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK:

Times tables practice – games, songs, oral reciting, TT Rockstars etc. can be used to support this at home. Year 4 will occasionally be given extra maths work to support their learning.

Britain: Can you find out the names of 5 major UK cities, 2 Major rivers in the UK and which cities they travel through? The names of the 5 highest mountains in the UK and what country they are in. (This is a trick! Don't let anyone tell you it includes Scarfell Pike and Snowdon!)

Faith: Our value this half term is Truth and our bible verse is John 8 v 31-32 Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching; you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." What do you think it means to be free?

Creativity: For remembrance day we wear poppies. Design a remembrance badge. What other symbols could you include on your badge? Could you use 2 or 3 different symbols?
