<p>WEEKLY ENGLISH HOMEWORK: At least 10mins daily reading practice – AIM HIGH for 15mins a day! Spelling practice – look, cover check and write these words in sentences if needed. A new set of spellings will be sent home weekly.</p>	<p>WEEKLY MATHS HOMEWORK: Times tables practice – games, songs, oral reciting, TT Rockstars etc. can be used to support this at home. Year 4 will occasionally be given extra maths work to support their learning.</p>
<p>Language: What language do you and your family speak? Can you translate some of the information about yourself into your own language? If you are English speaking can you find out about the history of our language? Where did it come from?</p>	<p>Britain: You now live in or around Newmarket. Each week work on a different area of the poster, gathering information, writing it neatly, organising it then just before half term we will present these to the class. Use the information in the other boxes to help you.</p>	<p>Faith: Do you and your family have a faith? What do you know about your faith? Why is it important to you? If you don't have a faith....</p>

Did your family come from another country or another area of the UK or did they always live around Newmarket? What information do you know about where they are from?</p>	<p>Creativity: Complete your fact file (under people) with pictures, diagrams and images.
